## Spotlight on Montclair

#### **Bluebird Nesting Boxes**

Bluebirds are always looking for a place to nest. Three males recently came to claim just one Cypress wood nest box on a shed in Montclair. Bluebirds are cavity-nesting birds who prefer nest boxes. Locally available, ready-to-install nest boxes made of Cedar or pine can be bought for a reasonable price. They are easy to mount 7' high facing East and will last for years.

Locate the nest box 20' away from a bird bath or feeder. The nest box can be placed at any time of the year. You may have Bluebirds nesting this year and see nest building, feeding the young, juveniles fledge, and your adult pair come to raise their young year after year. They prefer eating bugs but may sometimes eat dried mealworms. We certainly need more bluebird nest boxes now, given the recent loss of our natural tree canopy and natural tree trunk cavities. Please consider adding a Bluebird nest box at your house. Building one can be a great family project for your children or grandchildren with your help. There are free plans online, or you can buy a nest box kit as well. Have you been thinking about this in the past? Now is the perfect time! You and your family will love it!
