## Spotlight on Montclair

#### STATUS OF OUR MARTINEZ POST OFFICE

Hurricane Helene caused water-related damage to the Martinez post office branch (125 Commercial Blvd, Augusta, GA 30907). It affected access to the main walkup lobby which will remain closed for the foreseeable future due to pursuant mold damage. They are often asked but there is no information yet from the Postal Service on when the lobby will reopen.

You can still use the post office. The rest of the post office remains open. This area includes the lobby with the private PO Boxes many in our area use, including our HOA board. There is a stand with various size cardboard mailing boxes, three dropdown doors for letters and a self-service kiosk for various services. The automated kiosk has a scale for weighing packages and a place for placing packages ready to be mailed as well. Self-services offered: ship packages, mail letters, print prepaid labels, upgrade services, renew your PO Box, scan and pay for products, and buy pre-printed Forever Postage.

In the same outside lobby is the Postmaster's door. As you walk into the building, it is to your right, facing you. If you experience any difficulty with your mail efforts in the outside lobby, you can receive help at the Postmaster's door from 8:30 am until 5:30 pm Monday through Friday and from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm on Saturdays. There is a bell on the wall to the left of the door to ring for service.





Besides getting help with packages, you can bring packages to the Postmaster's door, which are ready for mailing, notices for holding your mail, and pickup of your mail when returning from a trip, you mail to be held until your return. The postal service workers who help you at the Postmaster's door are very kind, patient, and knowledgeable.

We will look forward to when the damage is repaired and we can have a fully open Martinez Post Office, as I am sure the postal workers share. In the meantime, you can do all the same things you used to do in the walk-up counter lobby using the services mentioned above.
