## Montclair Pool Registration Pool Regulations (revised 2026)

**THE POOL AREA IS UNDER 24-HOUR RECORDED SURVEILLANCE. DURING TIMES WHEN NO LIFEGUARDS ARE ON DUTY IT IS SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK. GUESTS ARE ALLOWED ONLY WHEN LIFEGUARDS ARE ON DUTY.**

As a condition of membership, each member agrees that the Montclair Association, Inc., is absolved of all liability for any cause for action where it can be shown that there has been failure to comply with regulations stated herein.

The lifeguards are authorized to evict anyone violating or failing to comply with the regulations and to enforce such additional rule or regulations as may be referred to the Board of Governors, which may suspend pool privileges, at their discretion, for the violator and his entire family.

### **A. Age Restrictions:**

1. Children 5 years and younger ONLY are allowed to use the baby/wading pool, with an adult.
2. Children under 6 years of age must be accompanied by an adult to the pool or when using the restroom.
3. During busy hours, children (10 and over) should play in the four (4) foot area and remain clear of the three (3) foot area.
4. Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied and supervised by their parents or designated chaperone (16 and over) appointed by their parents at all times.

### **B. General**

1. Members must show their identification upon request and must register via the sign-in process upon entering the pool. The plus+ one rule is still valid for every membership and any other guests, beyond the plus+ one, must pay the required guest fee upon entering the pool.
2. Parents, whether present or not, are responsible for the conduct of their children and guests using Association facilities. Members will be asked to leave the pool if they do not adhere to the rules. **Lifeguard or Pool Manager issues a 1<sup>st</sup> warning and 2<sup>nd</sup> warning (child will sit out of the pool), the 3<sup>rd</sup> warning the member will be asked to leave the pool and parents will be contacted.**
3. Resident members delinquent in their assessments shall not be allowed to join the pool.
4. No pool membership refunds after July 4<sup>th</sup> (mid-season).
5. No pets will be allowed in the pool enclosure.
6. No alcoholic beverages will be consumed on the premises.
7. No smoking, Vaping, E-cigarettes inside the pool enclosure at any time.
8. The Association will not be responsible for loss or damage to personal property. Personal items will not be held at the concession stand.
9. Pool user fees are not transferable.
10. Pool user fees are not refundable after the pool season opens, except upon moving from Montclair.
11. Only employees are allowed in concession stand, pump house and on the lifeguard stands
12. NO members or guest will be allowed on top of the pump house.
13. Proper swimming attire must be worn in the pool. No thongs, street clothes or inappropriate swim attire will be allowed at the Montclair Pool. Members will be asked to leave if the attire is not appropriate.
14. No profanity on the premises.
15. A ten-minute break (“**adult swim**”) will be called 10 minutes before each hour. **Children should not be sitting on the edge or side of the pool during breaktime.**
16. **Only adults 18 and over and children 6 years and younger accompanied by an adult, may be in pool at this time.**

## C. Health and Safety

1. Children in disposable diapers are not allowed in the pool! All babies must wear a "Swim Diaper".
2. The manager or assistant manager may require anyone to shower before entering the pool.
3. Admission to the pool may be refused to anyone with colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, infections or to anyone wearing bandages. Admission will be refused to anyone with a communicable disease. Please do not enter the pool with open cuts or blisters due to the chance of infection.
4. All commonly recognized rules of sanitation and safety shall be observed.
5. Climbing on fencing is prohibited.
6. To ensure the safety of all pool participants, the pool staff reserves the right to close the pool in case of lightning, thunder or heavy rain. The reopening of the facility will be left to the discretion of the manager or assistant manager on duty.
7. **NO balloons, chewing gum, glass containers, or smoking are allowed inside the pool enclosure.**
8. No running, pushing, wrestling or undue disturbances shall be permitted in or about the pool area.
9. The maximum number of people allowed in the pool at one time is 125 (state health dept.)
10. Spitting, spouting of water, blowing the nose, etc., in the swimming pool is strictly prohibited.
11. No unnecessary conversation or loitering around the lifeguard on duty is permitted!!
12. **ONLY lifeguards, pool manager, and approved Board members are allowed in the pump house and concession stand!!!**

## CI. Wading Pool

1. The parent or responsible guardian must be in the baby/wading pool enclosure when a child is using the wading pool.
2. NO metal or rigid toys are allowed in the baby/wading pool area.
3. SWIM DIAPERS are the only diapers allowed to be used pool.
4. Children with diarrhea should not be brought to the pool.

## CII. Swimming Pool

1. **NO SOLO SWIMMING IS ALLOWED.**
2. **NO running around the pool or run-jumping into the pool.**
3. **Parents of non-proficient swimmers are responsible for their children at all times and must be in the water with the children when they are using swimmies (water wings) or floats.**
4. **NO balloons, food, gum, or glass shall be allowed on the pool deck or in the pool.**
5. Only one person shall be allowed on a diving board at one time. Others shall wait at the foot of the steps.
6. There will be no swimming or playing in the deep end if the diving boards are in use.
7. There will be no jumping or diving off the side of the diving boards. No hanging on the underside of the diving boards.
8. **NO diving in the shallow water.**
9. Swimming equipment, including swim fins, goggles, mask, snorkels, air mattresses, tubes, etc., will be allowed. **No personal flotation devices or floats will be permitted in the diving area,**
  - a. All items brought into the pool or area can be refused at any time by the lifeguards or pool manager.
10. **NO BALLS** are allowed in the pool area, i.e. tennis balls, baseballs, softballs, soccer balls. Softballs such as nerf, and beach balls will be acceptable when crowd conditions permit. To avoid hitting guests, Frisbees, volleyballs, etc., are permitted only OUTSIDE of fenced pool area.
11. **NO sitting or hanging on deep end rope.**
12. Diver must dive straight- out not to the side walls.

## CIII. Guests

1. **All guests must be accompanied by and registered by an active pool member. Members must be present for the entire time the guest is visiting. Each guest must be signed in to be at the pool.**
2. All guests are subject to all rules and regulations that apply to members
3. Guest Fee is \$5.00 a day with a \$20 cap per family.
4. Special permission is needed to have more than 5 guests on any one day.
5. Guests of members may enter the pool area without payment of guest fees provided they do not dress for swimming.

## G. Pool Parties

1. All pool members may enter the pool area and use the pool, even if a there is a party happening with other members.
2. Permission for a pool party must be requested in written form on a Pool Rental Application Form to the Pool Manager, at least ten days prior to the expected party date. Forms are available at the concession stand. The member sponsoring the party must be present at the party for the entire length of the party.
3. Appropriate lifeguard staff will be necessary for all parties during or after pool hours. The responsible party will be charged for each lifeguard needed.
4. The cost for rental of the pool will be \$75 an hour with a two-hour minimum PLUS \$15.00/hour for each lifeguard needed for the event. A minimum of two lifeguards must be scheduled for each party. All rental and Lifeguard fees are to be paid in advance with checks made payable to Montclair Association, INC
5. The member(s) hosting the party are responsible for clean-up and should arrange to have all trash picked up. The lifeguards are responsible for closing the facility, NOT clean-up.
6. If it rains during the first hour of your party, the party can be rescheduled at a convenient time by the Pool Manager.
